

User Outline

To access the encyclopedia, use the provided link and an approved password. Upon accessing the encyclopedia, you should see the following:



Arrows on the right and left side of the screen can be used to scroll through the encyclopedia pages as well as the buttons in the middle of the bottom menu bar. The left and right arrow keys on your keyboard can also be used.

The platform hosting the encyclopedia can be used to search for keywords, zooming in, adding notes, and making annotations. These features are accessible via the menu bars that run along the top and bottom of the encyclopedia. Outlines of these systems can be found below:

Search

The search feature can be found on the right side of the top menu bar. The search feature searches for abstracts that contain all words entered. To clarify, as an example - searching for two words “vitamins” “nutrition” will return only abstracts that contain the words “vitamins” “nutrition”.



Zoom

The zoom feature can be found on the left side of the bottom menu bar. Clicking the magnifying lens icon will increase the size of the currently opened page. Clicking on the icon again will zoom the page back out.



Notes

The notes feature can be found on the top right corner of the encyclopedia pages. By clicking on the icon, a window will pop up allowing for text notes to be added.



Annotations

The annotations feature can be found on the bottom right side of the bottom menu bar. By clicking on the icon, drawing tools will pop up allowing for notations to be added.
